

Rules for the allocation of M-modules via LSF for the summer semester 2024:

- The M-Modules will be given **in 2 consecutive phases**:
Phase 1: 01/03/2024|09:00 – 10/03/2024|18:00 (**allocation by priority**)
~~Phase 2: 23/03/2024|09:00 – 26/03/2024|18:00 (canceled)~~
Phase 3: 27/03/2024|09:00 – 27/03/2024|18:00 (**registration | waiting list**)
- The LSF system checks your course of study: only students **enrolled** in the following courses of study can take a M-Module place:
 - B. Sc. Biologie International
 - B. Sc. Biochemie Plus International
 - M. Sc. Biologie – zweijährige Variante
 - M. Sc. Biochemie
 - M. Sc. Biochemistry International
- The modules can be selected via the three courses in the LSF:

Phase 1 - allocation by priority:

- The time of voting **is not relevant**.
- In phase 1, you will set priorities.
- You can assign a priority to each module, i.e. each group in the course.
- For each group, you can set a personal priority using a drop-down list (e.g. apply for place priority 1 (high), apply for place priority 2 (less high), priority 10 (low),...). You can enter as many priorities as there are groups.
- The chance of getting a module **increases** if you specify **many** modules.
- You should not prioritise modules that you do not want to take.

• **Phase 3 - Registration | waiting list**

- In the last phase you can register for M modules, but you are **not directly admitted** to the module.
- After the last phase, the lecturers decide on admission to the module.
- For example, you can try to choose further modules or be put on the waiting list for a module that is already fully booked.
- Registration takes place directly in the individual module courses in the LSF (e.g.: [4410](#)).
